SPECIAL NOTICE:

- Please remember to complete the emergency contact form found in this packet before your first trip. We will keep it on file for each trip you take with us this year.
- Bus transportation is provided by various local bus companies and is indicated in each description. Their contact information is available. Do NOT call the bus company to register for a trip; call the office at Clearview Terrace to register for ALL bus trips.
- Our bus is usually available to board 15 minutes before departure time. It is helpful if you are here to board the bus and select your seat before our scheduled departure time.
- The times for home arrival are approximate. We cannot be responsible for traffic and other delays. Clearview Terrace is not liable for loss of personal property and/or personal injury.

- Our trip cost include round trip motor coach transportation (unless indicated otherwise), admission to event or tour, meals (tip included) and driver gratuity. Payment for trips is nonrefundable if cancellation is past the due date listed for each respective trip. Payment can be a money order, cash or check **payable to Clearview Terrace Travel Club**.

Some Tips for Travel...

- Bring a small, lightweight blanket and dress in layers. A blanket will give you your very own temperature control tool. Or just remove or add layers. It is hard to predict the temperature outside the bus!
- If you like to nap while we travel, bring along an inflatable neck pillow.
- A folding carry-on bag is ideal for storing purchases and makes it easy for you when the trip comes to an end to find all your goodies in one place.
- You are welcome to bring bottled water or beverage and snacks. Police your area for trash at all times.
- Be patient while traveling; enjoy the journey, not just the destination.
